Explore the evolution of racial oppression from slavery to mass incarceration

- 12:30 PM Tour of Selma & Walk across the Edmund Pettus Bridge
Meet with someone who was took part in the Bloody Sunday march at 11 years old. Hear their story.
Learn about Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel and his involvement in the struggle.
End by walking in their footsteps across the Edmund Pettus Bridge.
- 2:30 PM Depart for Birmingham
- 5 PM Context talk by Etgar 36. Introduction of Birmingham and it's crucial role in the Civil Rights Movement.
Walking tour of Freedom Park & 16th Street Baptist Church
Get a walking tour by a Reverend who was a Civil Rights worker in Birmingham in the 50s & 60s and was arrested and had the dogs & hoses turned on him. See the historic church where 4 girls died in a bombing.

1 PM	Leo Frank Story <i>Hear the story of Leo Frank, a New York Jew who moved to Atlanta, was falsely convicted of murder and was lynched. This has impacted the identity of Jews in the South since it occurred in 1915</i>
2 PM	Tour Auburn Ave and King Center Neighborhood and Tomb <i>Explore the area that Dr. King was born, grew up, and is buried in. See Old Ebenezer Church where 3 generations of King family preached. End our journey by paying our respects at Dr Martin Luther & Coretta Scott King's tomb.</i>
3 PM	Depart for Atlanta Airport
5 PM	Earliest flights out of Atlanta

ADULT CIVIL RIGHTS JOURNEY

The Civil Rights journey is one in which your participants will become empowered and inspired to come back home and get involved by realizing they currently have power to make a difference. They will meet with Reverends who worked and strategized with Dr. King as well as people who participated in the march from Selma to Montgomery. These are primary sources. We will also discuss Jewish involvement in the Movement and how our Passover story correlates so strongly with the Civil Rights story. By visiting the Equal Justice Initiative we help your participants understand that Civil Rights is not an issue that only impacted a specific people in the 1950s & 60s but is an ongoing issue today and being fought for by a variety of groups that have not felt they had a voice in the world.

CIVIL RIGHTS SUNDAY - TUESDAY TRIP COSTS:

25 - 50 people\$ 960 per person

20 – 24 people\$ 1,095 per person

\$210 single room supplement

IF EXTRA PEOPLE IN A ROOM:

3 in a room take \$60 off the price for each person
